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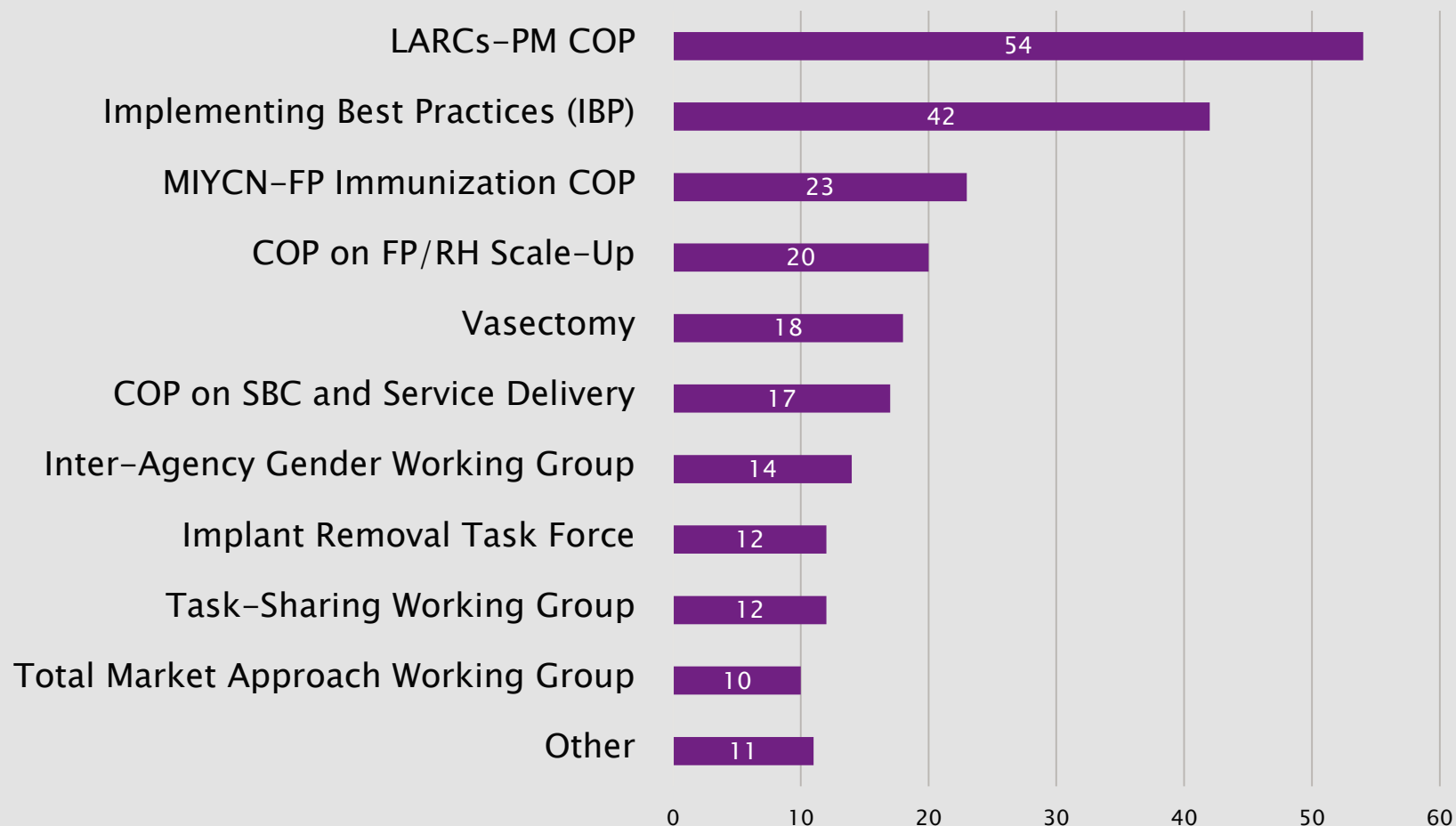

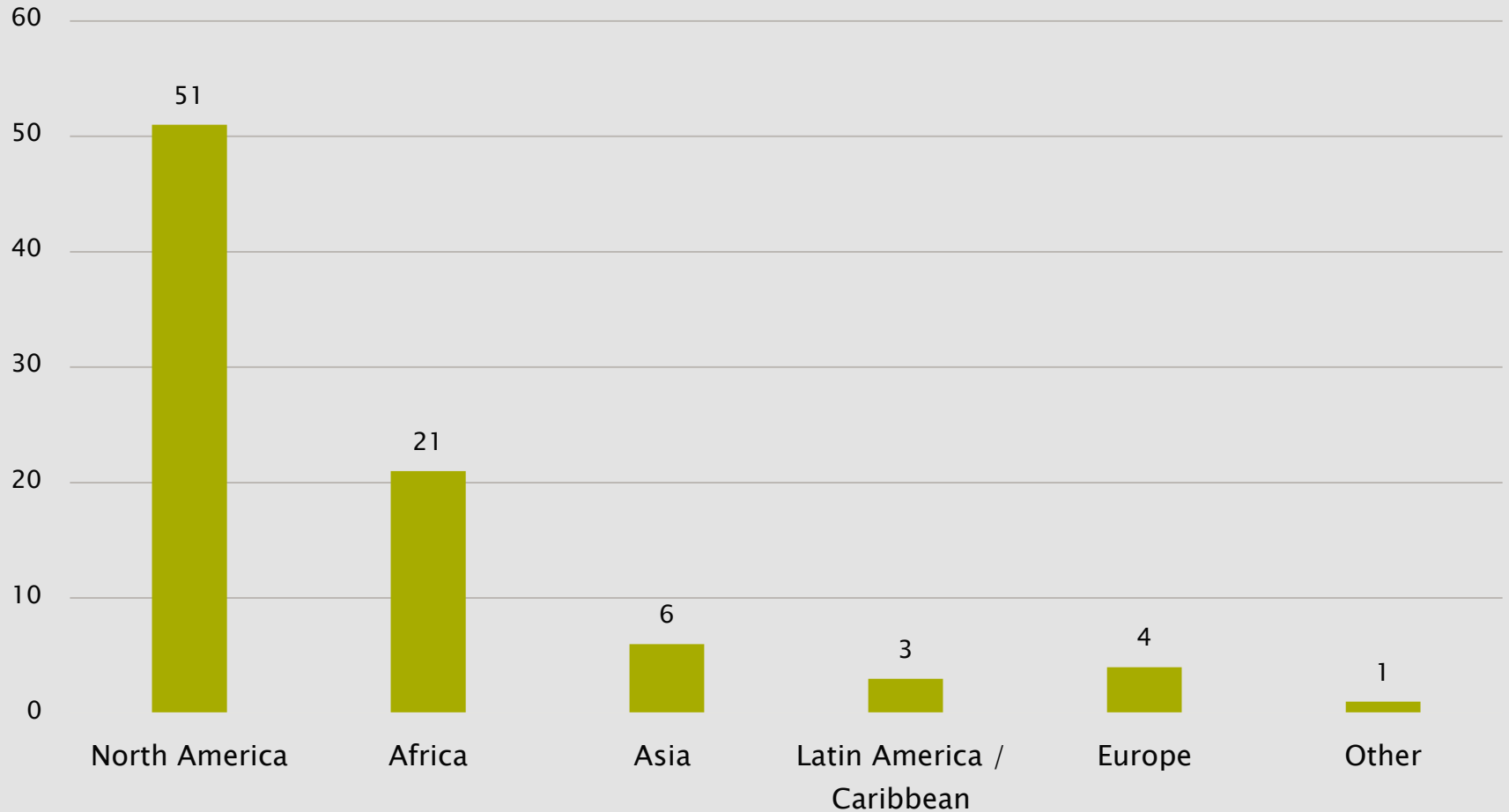

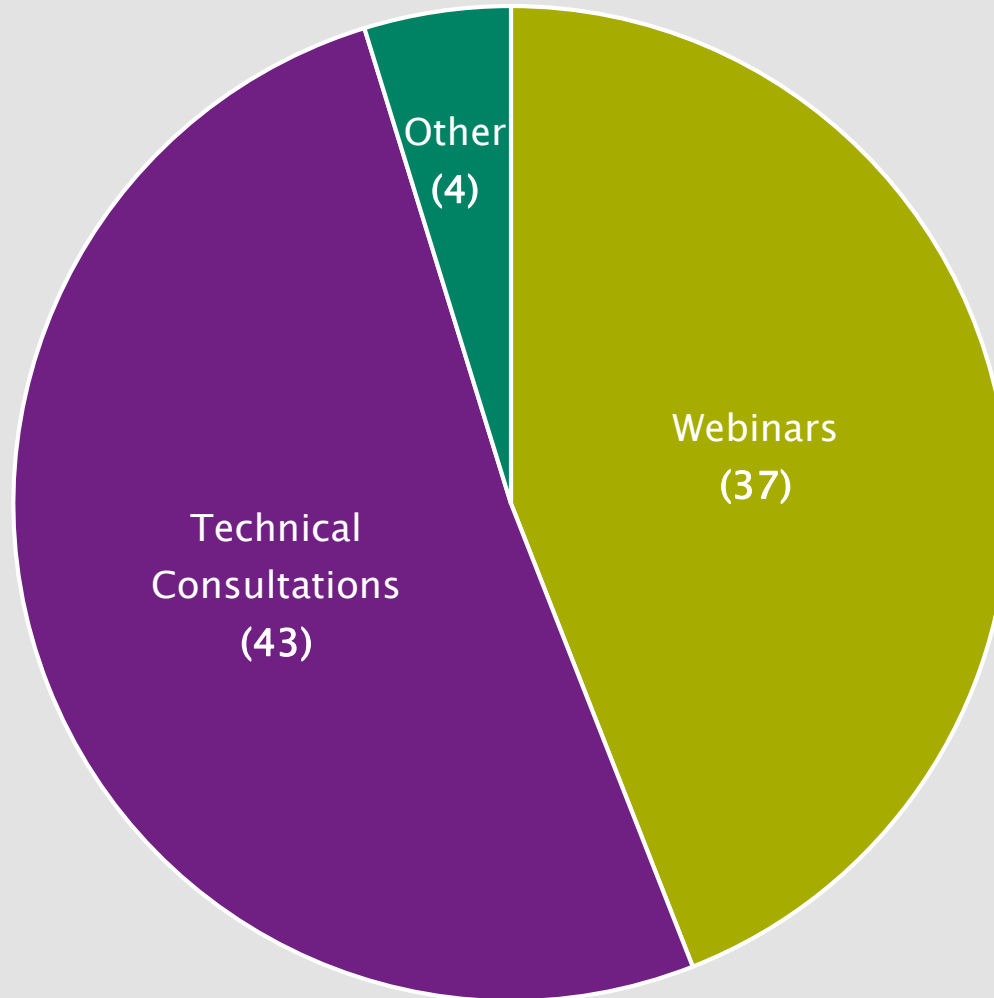
YOU BELONG TO THESE COPS, TWGS, AND TASK FORCES



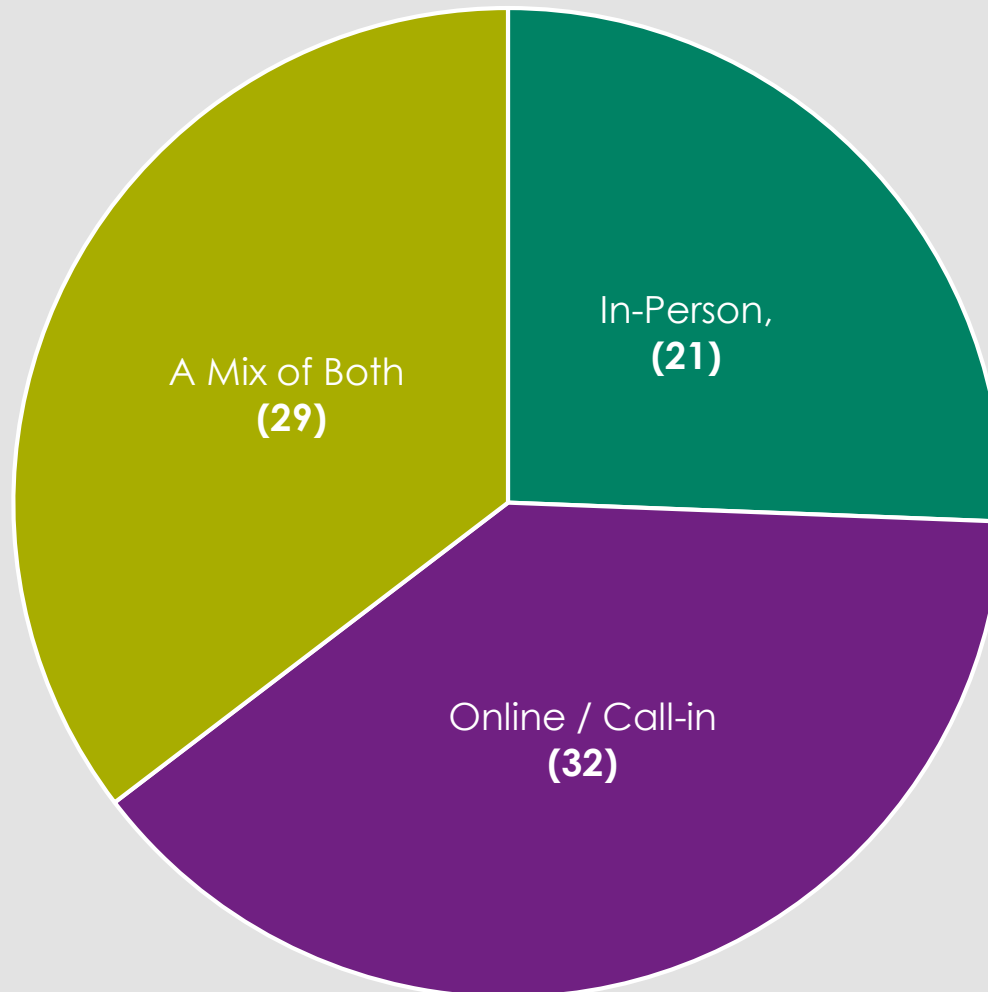
YOU ARE FROM...



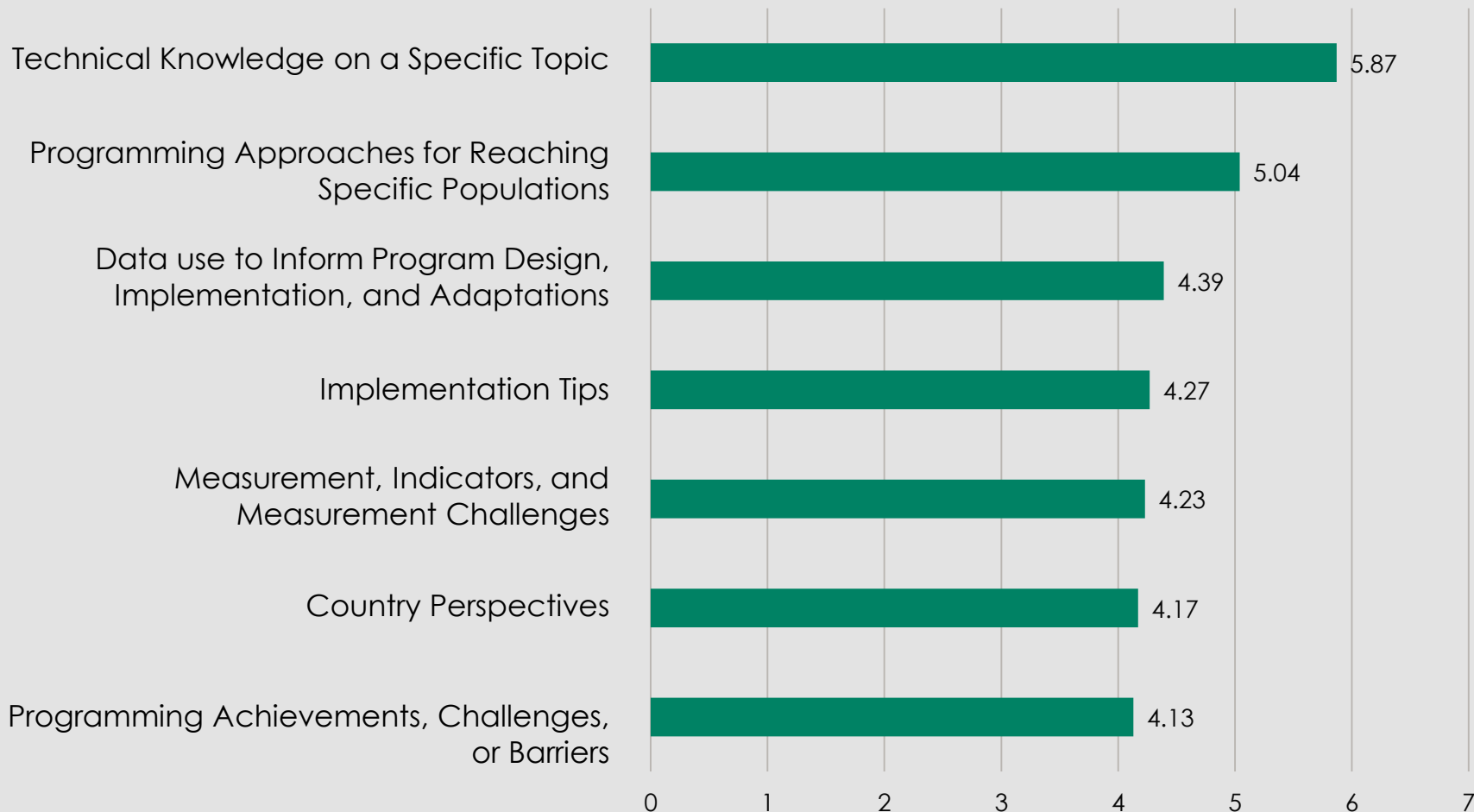
YOU FIND THESE COP EVENTS MOST USEFUL

YOUR THOUGHTS ON APPLYING LEARNING TO WORK

“Essentially, *information sharing* to ignite collaboration and prevent duplication of effort, which leads to more efficient use of donor resources.”

“Understanding trends in *new technology development* and demand for products among diverse market segments.”

“Understanding the latest data and programming approaches *helped with project design, work planning, and sharing* with country teams (cascading from COP events).”

“It gave me a deeper understanding of technical issues and how they are being *addressed in programming*.”

CHALLENGES YOU ENCOUNTERED

“Involve speakers/stakeholders who are not normally on the agenda or in the room, *involve the field*, create a safe space for debate, keep it technical.”

“Not having a *similar COP at regional or country level*.”

“The new COP should not simply be a rebranding of the LAPM COP. It should *tackle broader issues of method choice* across the full range of contraceptive options, including short-acting methods.”

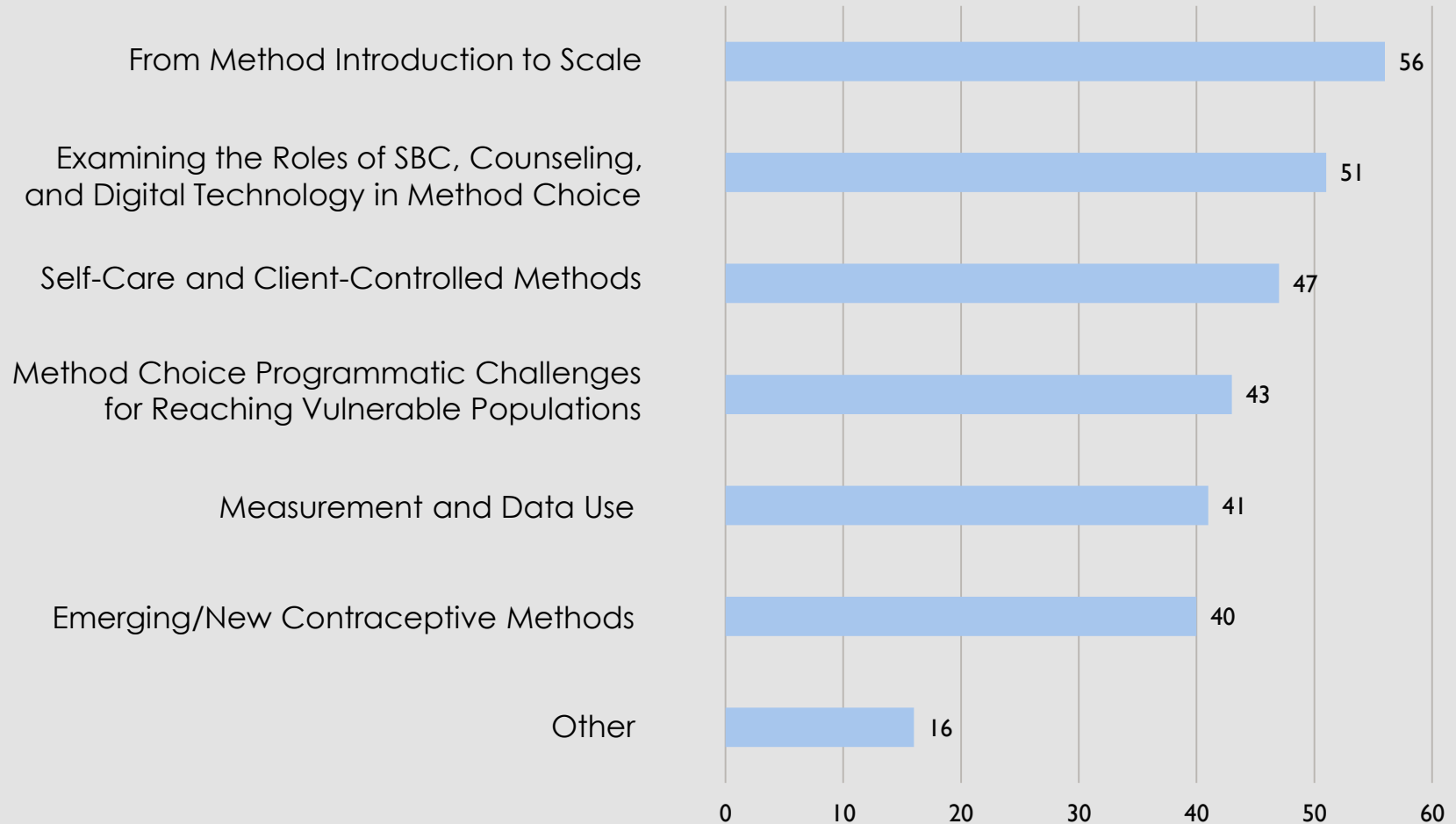
“COP seems *siloed* from cross-cutting TWGs (e.g. gender).”

“As it is such a large topic, it was often *difficult to come together around smaller topics*—so it was nice when smaller task teams or WGs, like the vasectomy group, spun off.”

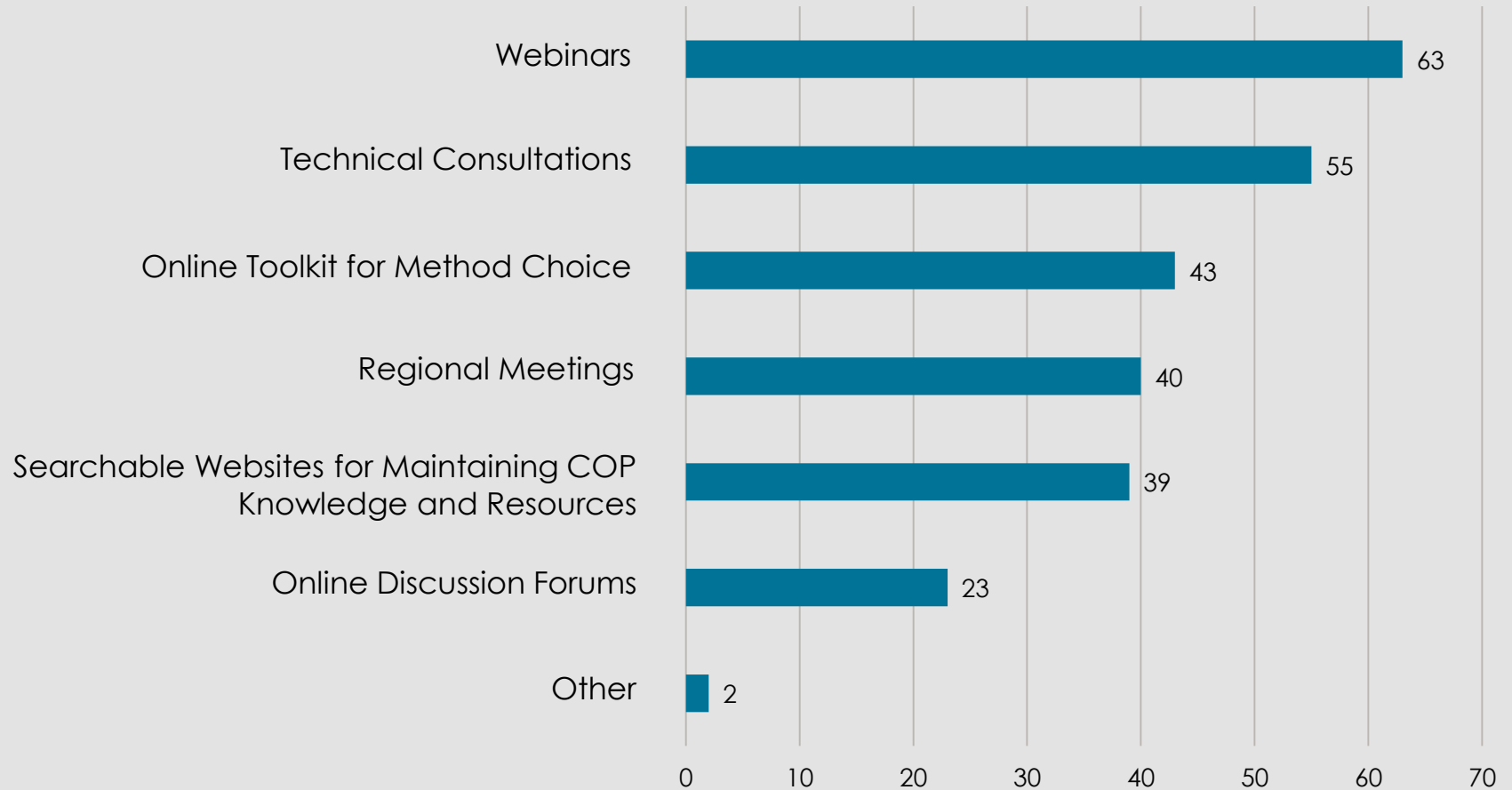
MOVING FORWARD

YOUR MOST PREFERRED PLATFORMS: WEBINARS AND TECHNICAL CONSULTATIONS

WEBINARS

- Host several per year
- Schedule during reasonable hours for LMIC participation
- Ensure availability in multiple languages
- Feature presenters from LMICs

TECHNICAL CONSULTATIONS

- Host at country/regional level with speakers from LMICs
- Partner with sub-regional organizations (e.g. Ouagadougou Partnership)
- Record for sharing with IPs, donors, missions, etc.
- Feature field voices

PROPOSED NEXT STEPS

- Create an aggregated mailing list of the CoPs, TWGs and task forces currently operational
- Convene planning session(s) to discuss modality of the Method Choice CoP with existing FP/RH TWGs and task forces
- Conduct one webinar per quarter in close collaboration with existing TWGs and task forces—recognizing field contribution
- Organize one technical consultation in DC in close collaboration with existing TWGs and task forces
- Partner with other organization/regional meetings to host joint technical consultation/s
